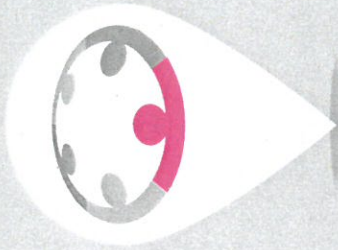

Why choose our Pay-As-You-Go Service?

Control - You deal with your case and are the point of contact for any parties involved, including the court and you do your own paperwork.
